

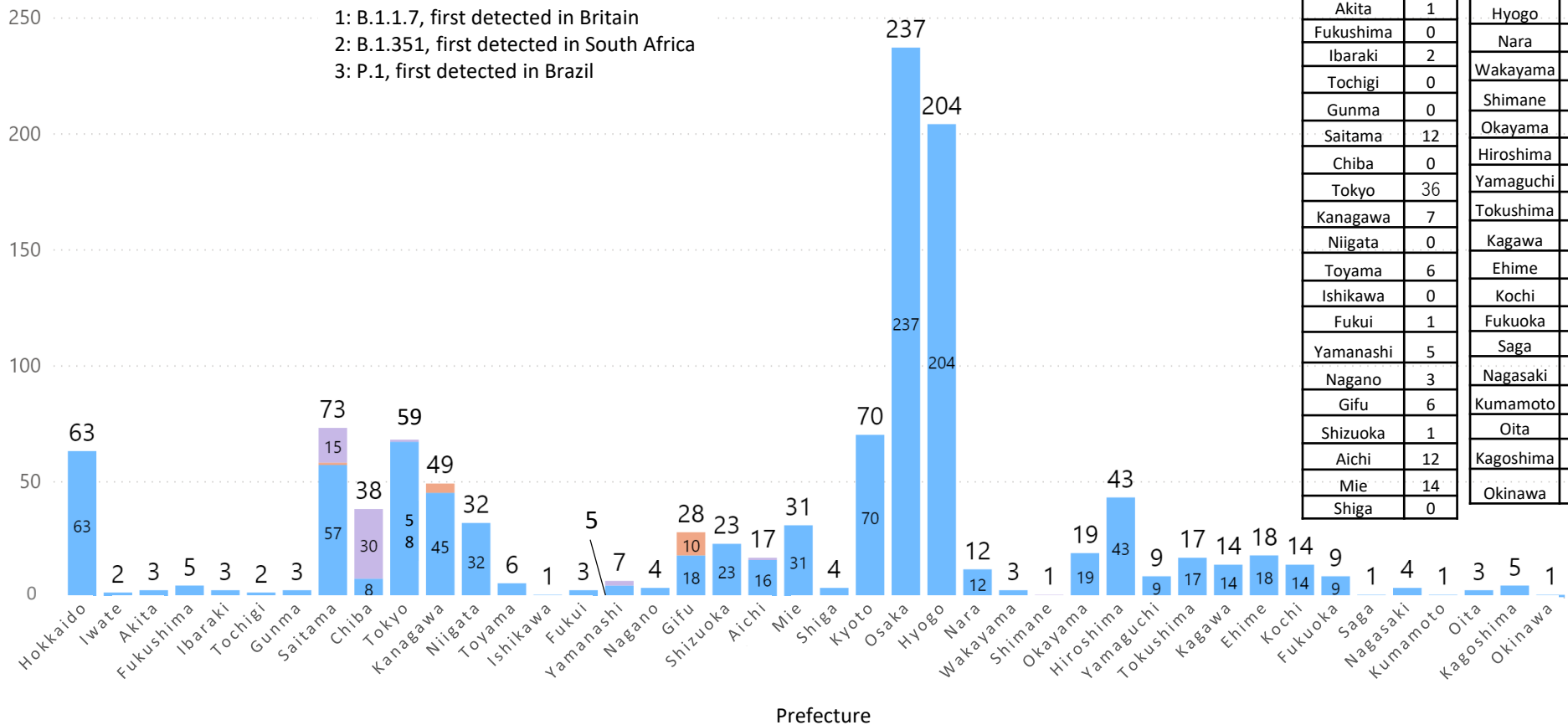
# Variant of Concern (VOC) cases confirmed by whole genome sequencing in each prefecture

- 1,341 (+303) cases were confirmed: 1,141 (+255) domestic cases and 200 (+48) cases in border screening.
- Type of variants: B.1.1.7:1,076 (+261) cases, B.1.351: 15 (+0) cases and P.1: 50 (+0) cases.
- ※Variants were confirmed in 42 prefectures (newly confirmed in Iwate, Toyama, Saga and Kumamoto).

 3: P.1, first detected in Brazil



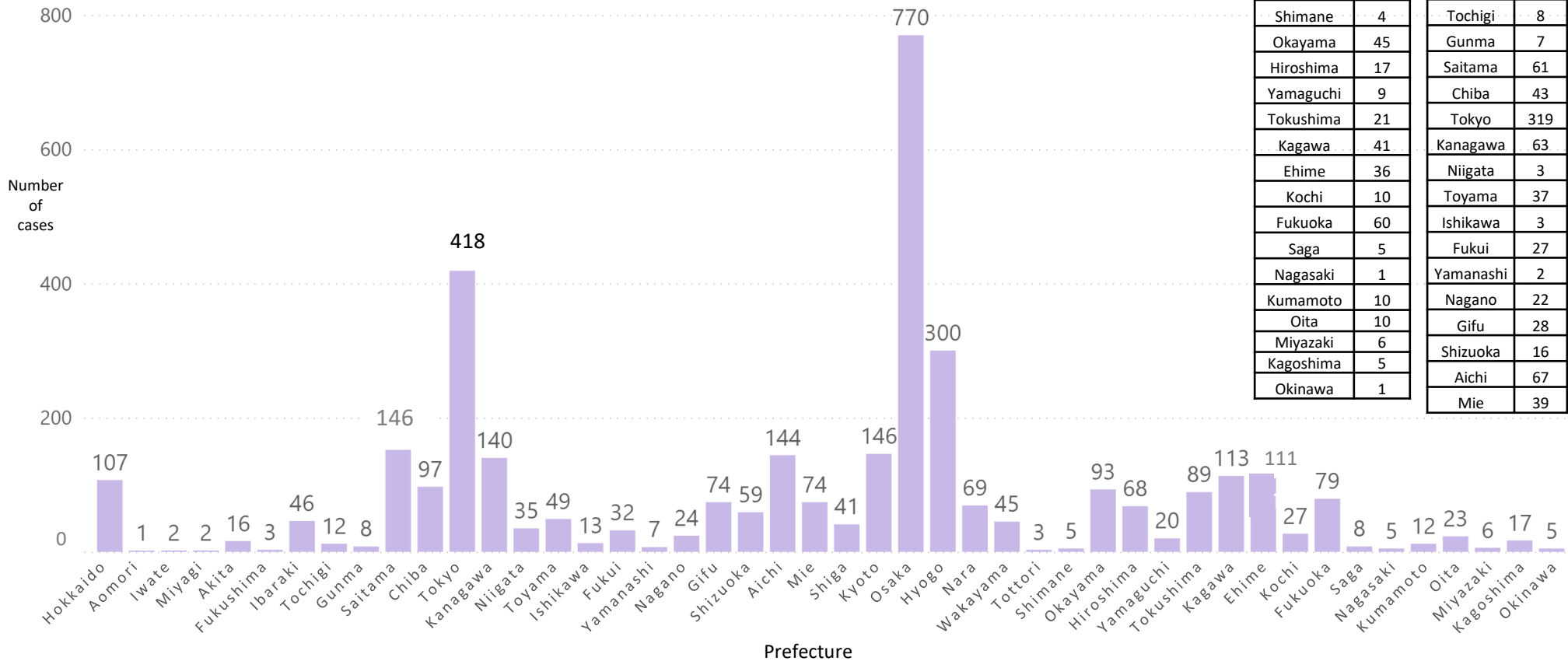
