





Your password must be at least 8 digits and include at least three of the following:

- Lowercase letter
- Uppercase letter
- Number
- Symbol

Step 7

- 1. Fill out your name, birthdate and phone number (attributes).
- 2. Enter your 6 or 7-digit ID.
- 3. Click the 'confirm' button, and the 'save attributes' button to complete registration.

■ How to Input Health Observations via Smartphone, etc.

Enter your health status from the homepage to make a report.

- 2 Click the 'confirm' button to complete your report.




→ Registration is now complete.


